Mount Vernon Community Preschool May 2023 Update



All-Church Conference

Delivering a needed, energy-efficient and sustainable renovation to the Education Wing Sunday, May 7th @ Noon

What: An all-church conference has been authorized by the District Superintendent to attend to the discussion and resolution of three vote items pertaining to a renovation project brewing for more than a decade.

The meeting will address three motions:

Should the church proceed with a renovation of the Education Wing with a contract issued to Apex Construction?

Should the church proceed with securing a short-term construction loan with Mount Vernon Bank & Trust Co.?

Should the church proceed with a capital campaign to cover the gap between cash accounts allocated for this renovation and the total construction bill?

Who: Any individual holding membership in this church can register a vote for each motion. Any individual interested in being part of the conversation is invited to attend. You must, however, hold membership to vote. Pastor Terra Amundson will serve as the elder required for this conference.

Where: Meeting will commence in the sanctuary promptly at Noon. A vision board will be on display in the Narthex beginning Sunday, April 30th through to the conference. It will then remain for further conversation after.

Julian Johnson Scholarship Available

College students who are entering either their junior or senior year at an accredited 4-year institution for the 2023-24 academic year and who are members of the United Methodist Church of Mount Vernon are eligible for the Julian Johnston Scholarship award administered by the church's memorial committee.

Julian Johnston, a former Mount Vernon businessman, provided for this scholarship in his will as appreciation for money he received from this church to enable him to finish his education at Cornell. Dividends from his Chevron stock given to the church provide the funding for this scholarship. Awards may be \$500 or \$1000 depending on the number of chosen applications and the actual funds available

Applicants need to 1) fill out a demographic information, 2) write a one-page letter describing the financial need and their career goals, and 3) provide a letter of recommendation to be considered by the evaluation committee. Application letters were emailed to our church members who were high school graduates in 2020 or 2021. Other eligible members may request application information from the church office. There is no age limit. Completed applications must be received by the church office by Friday June 2, 2023. Awards will be announced by June 30th.
