Pondering on the Paha:

John Pavlovitz in his book, "Worth Fighting For: Finding Courage and Compassion When Cruelty Is Trending" invites his readers to "remember how much is still worth fighting for. A rapidly heating planet being swallowed up by unchecked gluttony is worth it. A fractured nation teetering precariously on the edge of implosion is worth it. An American church that is poisoned with white supremacy and devoid of Jesus is worth it. The human and civil rights rapidly evaporating around us are worth it."

In July, we will begin a message series on Creating Community. We will explore the cause of divisions in our country, our community, and our homes. We will ask how we can become buildings of community in a culture that is focused on divisions. People are worth it. People matter. In John 17: 20-23, Jesus prays for the future church: "I ask not only on behalf of these but also on behalf of those who believe in me through their word, that they may all be one. As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me... I in them and you in me, that they may become completely one, so that the world may know that you have sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me." When we work together, it reveals Christ among us. Jesus promised his disciples that the world would know we are his followers by our love for each other.

Why is it so hard? How can we disagree with grace? How can we care for people who have become hard-hearted and closed-minded? I pray you join us this summer for this crucial series on Creating Community.

Message Series:

July & August

"Creating Community: Why can't we just get along?" In this 8- week series, we will address the stresses of living in community. Why are there so many arguments? Why are people so petty? Why am I afraid to confront them? Why is it so hard to get along? People have been fighting ever since Cain and Abel (and we all know how that ends). Even in the times of Jesus, the disciples fought and bickered. How can we have a healthier church community? How can we have



better fights with our loved ones? How can we avoid personal attacks even as we work on interpersonal conflicts? We will begin with scripture each week and add new tools to the relationship toolbox each week. This series begins July 7!

If you want to go deeper, I'd suggest "Crucial Conversations Tools for Talking When Stakes Are High" by Patterson and "Worth Fighting For" by John Pavlovitz.

July 14: "Creating Community: Who is the Greatest?" (The Sin Problem) Genesis 4:1-8, Luke 22:14-30

July 21: "Creating Community: Can you hear me now?" (Listening) Ephesians 4:25-32, James 1:19-27

July 28: "Creating Community: What stories am I believing?" (Reflection) Matthew 18:15-22, Psalm 139



- Prayers that love will spread across this world, that God's love will reach all the world


Prayers of Thanksgiving and Joy:
